



On June 24, 2022, the Supreme Court of the United States overturned Roe vs. Wade, leaving individual states' legislatures to determine the legality of abortion. LOTUS Legal Clinic recognizes that victims of human trafficking and sexual violence will be disproportionately impacted by this decision and will have an increased vulnerability to victimization because of it. LOTUS stands with our clients and their right to make the reproductive decisions that are right for them.
